ACADEMICS & ADVISING

How do I register for classes as an incoming freshman?

You can register through TigerWeb once you've received your login credentials. If your schedule has been created by your advisor, you can view it under the "Student Planning" section. If changes are needed, contact your academic department or advisor.

How do I find out who my academic advisor is?

If one hasn't been assigned yet, reach out to your department or college. For example, CAENS students should contact their CAENS advisor directly. Advisors are typically listed on your college's academic webpage.

What should I do if I have AP, IB, or dual enrollment credits?

Submit your official college transcript (for dual enrollment) or AP/IB score report directly to the Office of Admissions. High school transcripts alone are not sufficient.

Can I change my major before classes begin?

Yes. Email your request to admissions@tuskegee.edu and copy the dean of your intended new college. If your schedule has already been created, you may also need to email zbell@tuskegee.edu to update it accordingly.

TIGERWEB & TECH ACCESS

I can't access my TigerWeb account or two-factor authentication is locked to my parent's phone. Help?

Contact the Help Desk at helpdesk@tuskegee.edu or (334) 727-8040 to resolve login issues and reset authentication.

Where do I upload my ID photo?

FINANCIAL AID, SCHOLARSHIPS & BILLING

How do I know if I'm financially cleared?

Log in to TigerWeb to check your financial status. For questions, contact the Bursar's Office at bursar@tuskegee.edu or (334) 727-8538.

When is the financial clearance deadline?

Financial clearance is typically due by July 15, with a late fee assessed after August 20.

How do I accept my financial aid?

Email awoodson@tuskegee.edu with your student ID and the specific loans or awards you wish to accept.

Can I apply outside scholarships or work-study?

Yes. Contact the Office of Financial Aid to apply outside scholarships and inquire about work-study eligibility.

HOUSING & MOVE-IN

What are the move-in dates for Fall 2025?

Students with last names A–L: August 12
Students with last names M–Z: August 13
Athletes and special groups may have earlier dates communicated directly.

Where do we report on move-in day?

Go directly to your assigned residence hall to check in and receive your keys from the Hall Director.

What appliances are allowed in the dorms?

Mini fridges are allowed. Air fryers, hot plates, and space heaters are not. You may bring fans and air purifiers. Microwaves are usually available in common areas.

How much does laundry cost on campus?

\$2 per wash or dry cycle, paid via a mobile app.

Request a copy of your final high school/college transcript be sent directly to Tuskegee University. Include AP/IB scores as well.
